1. OVERVIEW

The TIS TOPPER 2027 Scholarship Examination is a merit-based academic competition conducted by Toppers International School ("TIS" or "the School") to identify and reward academically exceptional students. The Scholarship offers eligible candidates tuition fee waivers ranging from 25% to 100%, inclusive of Uniform Fees and Textbook Fees, based on their performance in the examination.

By registering for and/or participating in the TIS TOPPER 2027 Scholarship Examination, the student and their parent/guardian ("Applicant") acknowledge, accept, and agree to be bound by these Terms & Conditions in their entirety.

2. ELIGIBILITY

2.1 The Scholarship Examination is open to students seeking enrolment in Grades 6, 7, and 8 at Toppers International School for the 2027 Academic Year.

2.2 Applicants must complete the full online registration process at toppersschool.com/scholarships.php before the registration deadline of 31 October 2026.

2.3 Registration is deemed complete only upon verification of the confirmation link sent to the registered email address. Incomplete registrations will not be considered valid.

2.4 Each student may register and sit for the examination only once per intake cycle.

2.5 TIS reserves the right to disqualify any applicant who provides false, misleading, or incomplete information during the registration process.

3. EXAMINATION STRUCTURE

3.1 The TIS TOPPER 2027 Scholarship Examination evaluates candidates across the following three core subjects:

Subject	Assessment Scope
Mathematics	Individual Score + Overall Aggregate
Science	Individual Score + Overall Aggregate
English	Individual Score + Overall Aggregate

3.2 The examination is designed in alignment with the Cambridge International Lower Secondary curriculum standards.



3.3 The format, duration, and examination date will be communicated to registered candidates via their verified email address.

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR SCHOLARSHIP CONSIDERATION

4.1 To be considered for a Scholarship Award, a candidate must achieve a minimum score of 85% or above in each of the following:

- Mathematics — individual subject score
- Science — individual subject score
- English — individual subject score
- Overall Aggregate Score — combined across all three subjects

4.2 All four conditions stated above must be satisfied simultaneously. A candidate who fails to achieve the 85% minimum threshold in any single component — whether in an individual subject or in the overall aggregate — will not be eligible for a Scholarship Award, irrespective of their performance in the remaining subjects.

4.3 Achieving the minimum cut-off of 85% does not in itself guarantee a Scholarship Award. Eligibility places the candidate in the Scholarship Selection Pool, from which final awardees are determined strictly by rank.

5. SCHOLARSHIP AWARD STRUCTURE

5.1 From the pool of eligible candidates (those meeting all 85% cut-off conditions as stated in Clause 4), Scholarship Awards shall be granted based on overall rank as follows:

Rank	Scholarship Award
1st Place	100% Tuition Fee Waiver (incl. Uniform & Textbook Fees)
2nd Place	100% Tuition Fee Waiver (incl. Uniform & Textbook Fees)
3rd Place	50% Tuition Fee Waiver (incl. Uniform & Textbook Fees)
4th Place	50% Tuition Fee Waiver (incl. Uniform & Textbook Fees)
5th Place	25% Tuition Fee Waiver (incl. Uniform & Textbook Fees)



5.2 Rankings shall be determined by the overall aggregate score across all three subjects. In the event of a tie, the following tiebreaker sequence shall apply:

1. Higher score in Mathematics
2. Higher score in Science
3. Higher score in English
4. If still tied, TIS reserves the right to conduct an additional assessment or resolve the tie at its sole discretion.

5.3 A maximum of five (5) Scholarship Awards shall be granted per Grade per examination cycle. Should fewer than five eligible candidates qualify within a given cycle, only the applicable ranks shall be awarded. Unfilled award positions will not be carried forward or redistributed.

6. NATURE OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

6.1 The Scholarship Award constitutes a fee waiver covering Tuition Fees, Uniform Fees, and Textbook Fees, applied against the standard charges at TIS for the Grade in which the student enrolls:

- Grade 6 & 7: SGD 1,075 per month
- Grade 8: SGD 1,200 per month

6.2 The Scholarship covers Tuition Fees, Uniform Fees, and Textbook Fees only, and does not extend to registration fees, examination fees, or any other ancillary charges unless expressly stated in the official Scholarship Award Letter.

6.3 The Scholarship is awarded for the enrolled academic year and is subject to annual review. Continuation of the Scholarship in subsequent academic years is at the sole discretion of TIS and may be conditional upon satisfactory academic performance and conduct.

6.4 The Scholarship is non-transferable, non-negotiable, and may not be exchanged for cash or any other benefit.

6.5 Scholarship recipients must formally accept enrolment at TIS within the deadline specified in the Scholarship Award Letter. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of the award, which may subsequently be offered to the next eligible candidate.



7. EXAMINATION CONDUCT & INTEGRITY

7.1 All candidates are required to sit the examination in person, under the supervision of TIS-designated invigilators, at the TIS School Campus, 777 Upper Serangoon Rd, Singapore.

7.2 The use of calculators, electronic devices, reference notes, or any unauthorized materials is strictly prohibited unless explicitly permitted in the examination instructions.

7.3 Any form of academic dishonesty — including but not limited to cheating, impersonation, or collusion — will result in immediate disqualification from the examination and forfeiture of any award. TIS reserves the right to take such further action as it deems appropriate.

7.4 Results may be withheld or annulled at any stage, including after provisional results have been communicated, if TIS determines that a breach of examination integrity has occurred.

8. RESULTS & NOTIFICATION

8.1 Examination results will be communicated to registered candidates via their verified email address within the timeframe specified by TIS following the examination date.

8.2 Results are final and binding. While TIS will endeavor to address genuine concerns regarding clerical or administrative errors, no formal appeal or re-marking process is available.

8.3 TIS reserves the right to withhold results where an investigation into examination irregularities is ongoing.

9. PRIVACY & DATA USE

9.1 Personal data collected during registration will be used solely for the administration of the TIS TOPPER 2027 Scholarship Examination and for student enrolment purposes.

9.2 TIS will not disclose personal data to third parties without the consent of the applicant, except as required by applicable law.

9.3 By registering, the applicant consents to TIS using the student's name, grade, and scholarship status for school publications, social media, and marketing materials. Applicants who object to such use must notify TIS in writing prior to the examination date.

9.4 TIS reserves the right to use a Scholarship recipient's name and photograph for the purpose of publicizing Merit Scholarship results on the School's website, social media platforms, and other marketing or promotional materials produced by TIS. Applicants



who wish to opt out of photo usage must submit a written request to the Admissions Office prior to the examination date.

10. GENERAL CONDITIONS

10.1 TIS reserves the right to amend, suspend, or cancel the Scholarship Examination at any time due to unforeseen circumstances, with reasonable prior notice to registered candidates.

10.2 TIS's decision in all matters relating to the Scholarship Examination — including but not limited to eligibility, results, rankings, and awards — is final and binding.

10.3 These Terms & Conditions are governed by and shall be construed in accordance with the laws of Singapore. Any disputes arising in connection with the Scholarship Examination shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Singapore.

10.4 In the event of any conflict or ambiguity between these Terms & Conditions and any other communication — whether verbal, written, or otherwise — these Terms & Conditions shall prevail.
